Not all _____⁽¹⁾, or masses of abnormal tissue, are cancerous and can spread. Cells from cancerous, or _____⁽²⁾, tumors can break away and move through lymph or blood vessels and spread to healthy tissues. This is known as _____⁽³⁾. Some cancer risk factors, such as age and family history, cannot be changed. Others, such as _____⁽⁴⁾ and use of known cancer-causing substances, or _____⁽⁵⁾, such as tobacco, can be controlled.

There are three basic approaches to treating cancers. One method, _____⁽⁶⁾, involves the removal of tumors and affected areas. Certain types of cancer are treated successfully with _____⁽⁷⁾, which penetrates the tumor and destroys the tumor cells by damaging DNA in the nuclei. The third method, _____⁽⁸⁾, involves the use of anticancer medications that interfere with division of the cancer cells.
